## 8 & 9 BALL LEAGUE RULES AND CONDITIONS 2011 SEASON

- 1 All matches are to be played under World Rules as adopted by the New Zealand Pool Association and all Regional Associations affiliated to the NZPA.
- 2 Both teams will list their teams independently, then the Home Team will put the names of their team players on the score sheet first and the Visiting Team will then put in the names of their team players. Listing is to be random with no team having an advantage in the placing of the players.
- 3 The matches will start between 7.00 pm and 7.30 pm.
- 4 Players must wear a collared shirt (polo shirts acceptable).
- 5 The venue shall provide two free-playing tables to be used for League matches.
- 6 There will be no coaching while a match is in progress.
- 7 The Captain's are to sign and check both score sheets.
- 8 The **Home Team Captain** is solely responsible for the collection of player fees and score sheets on the night of play and will post to The League Co-ordinator, APA, PO Box 24-597, Royal Oak, Auckland, or deliver to 713 Mt Albert Rd, Royal Oak to be received no later than one week following the night of play.
- 9 **Pairs:** Partners may not converse at any time during pairs matches unless determining who is to break. Any infraction of this rule is a foul and the opposing pair have ball in hand.
- 10 Anything arising, not mentioned in the above rules and conditions, will be decided by the Auckland Pool Association Management Committee.
- 11 In the event of a tie, the team with the better frame count will get the highest position in the post-section draw.
- 11a All prizes will be paid at the end of the season. **Team captains will be responsible for allocation of prize money to team members and no recourse may be made to the Auckland Pool Assoc.**
- 12 Any queries should be directed to the League Co-ordinator.
